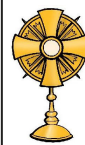

## Scrip Scoop

### How much can Scrip really help the Mary, Seat of Wisdom Campaign?

## A Word From The Pastor

Congratulations to all of the graduates of our parish! This weekend at Mass we salute the young men and women who are completing their high school education, and we pray that God will lead them and guide them as they take the next steps in their life. We also congratulate the college graduates from our parish who will now be trying to put those diplomas to good use. Finally, I would like to offer a special word of congratulations to the nine young people who graduated from St. Mary's School this past Thursday. Graduation is a special time in everyone's life normally filled with hope and promise as well as fear and apprehension. None of us knows what tomorrow will bring, but the most important lesson we can learn is to trust that God will always be there with us through whatever might come our way. The best decision that we can make is to put the talents and abilities God has given us at His service and pray that He shows us how best to use them. That is my prayer for all of our graduates, and everyone else in the parish as well!

This Saturday the diocese of Grand Rapids ordained four men as new priests in service of the Lord. This is the first time since the early 1990's that there have been this many ordained at one time. I believe that God has continued to call just as many young men to serve Him, but the voices of this world have been doing a better job of drowning out His voice. I am so grateful that Fathers Tom, Colin, Jegar, and Dan have said yes to this great calling and set out on this wonderful adventure of the priesthood. Being a priest has its ups and downs, but it always brings tremendous joy. There have been a large number of retirements and health concerns among the priests of our diocese, and I welcome the "new blood" to help to minister to God's people. The role of pastor has become more demanding over the years, so I would ask everyone to keep these men in your prayers that they might be equipped for the challenges they will face!

The building project continues to move forward at a very rapid pace. We are on pace to be able to begin moving in during early November, as planned.
