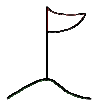

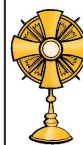

## A Word From The Pastor

This past Wednesday marked one year since my mother's pulmonary embolism almost took her life. I am so grateful to God and to all of those who offered prayers for her and for our family as we dealt with that situation last summer. I am happy to report that she has had what can only be termed a miraculous recovery, and although she is not back 100% to where she was before, she is pretty close. She has even been able to sing in the diocesan choir for Chrism Mass and the priestly ordinations two weeks ago. I am very appreciative of all of the support I received from the parish during my mother's illness, my own battle with mono, and the finishing up of my canon law degree. You certainly have treated me very well, and I am blessed to be your pastor! I am so happy to be able to stay in Spring Lake this summer.

You can see your pastor in action this Thursday evening as I join the other priests of the diocese in the Let's Go to Bat for Kids softball game at Fifth Third Ballpark. The game is put on by Catholic Charities of West Michigan and raises money for their family strengthening programs in this area. Gates open at 5:30 for this free event, but parking is \$6 per car. You can get more information on the Catholic Charities website at [www.ccwestmi.org](http://www.ccwestmi.org). They are asking people to register for the event online if possible, even though it is free. However, even if you don't sign up online, you can still just show up to watch. We will be playing a number of media celebrities from the Grand Rapids area. This promises to be a fun time, so come out and cheer on the priests of the diocese!

Great progress continues to be made on our new education center! Hopefully, by the time you are reading this, the concrete floor will have been poured, and this upcoming week they are scheduled to put the roof/ceiling on the first floor. Thanks to the great work that the block layers are doing, we are within a few days of being right on schedule. We are still planning that everything will be finished in early-mid November so that we can move in either around Thanksgiving or Christmas. They have now begun to add the second floor to the existing building, which has necessitated removing the air conditioning units that service the nursery and music rooms. We are assessing whether it will be too hot to open the nursery for the next few months or not, but we ask that you please be patient and bear with us as we go through the "growing pains" of adding this additional space.

Related to this, they will be doing work on the parking lot along Exchange over the next few weeks. When this is completed we will have several additional parking places, and hopefully better traffic flow. Until then, try to treat your neighbor with kindness and allow those who find it difficult to walk to have the closest parking places.

Please continue to keep the new education center and school project in your prayers. We are also continuing to look for donors for that project and for our CSA/church renovation project. The more we are able to raise this year, the smaller our long term loan from the diocese will be and the easier it will be to pay everything off. Thank you once again for all of the generosity that has been shown toward your parish!
